Engineering Updates

PW22RR - Road Resurfacing

This is a massive project that will resurface approximately 30 miles of roadways while also improving curb and sidewalk crossings. Existing sidewalk connections will be updated to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. This will involve rebuilding any existing sidewalk crossings that do not comply with ADA requirements and adding new sidewalk crossings and related drainage features in areas where they do not currently exist (please see pictures below).

This is the largest resurfacing project the Village has ever undertaken, spanning the entire Village. We kindly ask residents to remain patient as we complete the pre-bidding process in Q4 2024 and prepare to begin construction in late Q4 2024 or early Q1 2025. Engineering Updates

Cultural Center Porte Cochere

The Cultural Center is set to receive a porte cochere, which will provide covered access to the building, enhancing convenience and accessibility for visitors. Bids for the project were opened earlier this month, and after review, construction is anticipated to begin in the spring. This new addition will improve the overall experience for guests, offering shelter from the elements as they arrive at the center. AT&T work within Willows

Work for AT&T began on January 13, 2025, and is expected to take approximately six months, progressing in multiple phases throughout the area outlined in the attached map. Excavation work will take place within the public right-of-way and utility easements. The public right-of-way begins at the owner's property line at the back edge of the sidewalk and extends across the street to the back of the opposite sidewalk. It is important to note that this area is publicly owned, and the adjacent property owner neither owns nor pays taxes on this land. The utility company, authorized by its permit from the Village, is permitted to work on this land.
