#### **IMPORTANT:**

Vote-by-Mail ballot requests expired on December 31, 2024, per state law. You must submit a new request for elections in 2025 - 2026.

# **★ RETURN IT**

- ► Vote-by-Mail ballots must be received by March 11, 2025, by our Main Office at 7:00 p.m. or by 5:00 p.m. at one of our Branch Offices.
- ▶ By mail: Postage is pre-paid. Please allow seven (7) days to mail before Election Day.
- ▶ In-person: At one of our four (4) offices during business hours. Visit VotePalmBeach.gov for times and locations.

# **★ TRACK IT**

Opt-in to get alerts via email, text (SMS), and/or voice message when your ballot has been mailed out, received by our office, or if there is an issue with your ballot so that it can be corrected right away.







- ▶ Election Day polls are open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.
- ▶ You must vote at the polling location that is assigned to your precinct.
- ▶ Polling locations may change! Visit VotePalmBeach.gov or call (561) 656-6200 to confirm your polling place before you go vote.
