



### IMPORTANT:

Vote-by-Mail ballot requests expire after each General Election. If you already enjoy voting by mail and wish to continue voting by mail in any 2025 - 2026 elections, you must submit a new Vote-by-Mail ballot request.

### ANY REGISTERED VOTER MAY REQUEST A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT.

When requested, we mail your ballot to you wherever you will be, and you can take your time making your voting decisions.

### HIGHLIGHTS

Return postage is pre-paid

You can track your ballot from when you request it to when it's counted

Make sure you sign your envelope

### REQUESTING A MAIL BALLOT

The deadline to request that a ballot be mailed to you is 5:00 p.m. on the 12th day before Election Day.

### Helpful Tips

- ★ Carefully mark your ballot from home at the time most convenient for you, then mail it in or drop it off at one of our secure locations.
- ★ If returning your ballot by mail, we recommend that you allow at least 5-7 business days for your ballot to be received by our office.
- ★ Vote-by-Mail ballots must be received by our Main Office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.
